

Alamance Artisans Meeting October 20, 2025

After a social time, the meeting was called to order with 13 members and one guest present.

Visitor Charlotte Thompson, a painter was welcomed and members introduced themselves.

Treasurer's Report: Current balance is \$8,920.63. It was noted that there is \$539.90 from Fall Into Art, for future events. There was discussion of the rental of grids for FIA. The \$125 cost covered all grids, connectors, and other hardware. It was noted that the group will need more volunteers to help move the large quantity of grids available, and to be sure to pick up all the extra pieces with the grids.

The minutes of the September meeting were reviewed and approved.

Fall Into Art:

Overall this was a very positive experience, continuing the celebration of Alamance Artisans' 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

There was no cost to the group for the event.

It was organized in only 4 months.

ACC was very helpful with design of printed materials.

Harris Teeter donated food and drinks.

Choosing to only hold the event on one day had pluses and minuses.

The ACC facility was very nice, though more people are needed to help with logistics.

Using ACC during Fall Break allowed better access to the building, but limited the amount of student traffic and student volunteers for the event.

The size of the space limited the number of artists, which may have impacted the turnout.

Having more time to plan and organize an event of this type is best.

We made excellent contacts with the folks at ACC.

Other events and opportunities:

Alamance Arts Affiliate Shelves will be available sometime in January.

Our next Center for Creative Leadership show will be in 2027.

Inquiring about another show at Alamance Arts in 2026, but nothing definitive right now.

Need to start early to plan for a Fall 2026 show.

Members are still needed to show their 2-D art at Harrison's Restaurant.

Alamance Arts Eyes on Alamance theme is Color.

There was discussion of using the Mebane Arts Center for a monthly show or for a big event.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned for a program by Jan Holloman on how to make a photo book of your artwork.
