The Treasurer's Report was presented. The ending checking account balance as of April was \$10,166.79. Martha Sink, Treasurer, also reported that the check from Marshall Muse for the sales at the spring show is ready. She will deposit it and then pay the artists.

Rita reported for Dottie that we have 4 new patrons for 2025-26. She reminded us to support Alamance Arts. They are having a fund raising event at Red Oak Brewery on June 11. There will be a Veteran's exhibit at Captain White House again opening July 7. Active duty military, veterans and their families are invited to participate.

Deb Barnett reported that the spring show at Marshall Muse was well attended. It increased our presence in the public eye through attendance at First Fridays, Second Saturdays and our reception at the gallery, and social media postings by us and Marshall Muse. Our website was visited more times than usual as were our Facebook pages. The August show deposit has been made. It is on Alamance Arts' calendar. Participating artists are asked to send images for a postcard to Anita by June 14.

Other artist opportunities include Art Stock in Greensboro in the fall, The Marshall Muse Gallery summer music series. We still need to fill the schedule for the affiliate shelves at Captain White House. We will be showing at The Center for Creative Leadership in April 2027.

We enjoyed a fun program presented by Rita Duxbury who took us around the building to see Arty the Mouse and read the story to us as we made mice from supplies she furnished.
